- Players will compete in the Football Queensland Junior Premier League Round Robins.
- Players will be eligible for selection to the Queensland Team relevant to their age.

Centre of Excellence Under 14 Girls

- Players will play in a fulltime team in the Maryborough/Hervey Bay Competition.
- Competition will be in the Under 15 Boys competition.
- Players will train with their team in Maryborough on a Thursday night. This will alternate fortnightly with the Under 12 boys.
- Players will train weekly in their local CA Centre on a designated night with a designated coach.
- Players will play their games on a Saturday morning.
- Players will be eligible to play into the finals.
- Players will not be able to play for a Club in their CA.
- Players will not be able to play for their CA Representative Team
- Players will compete in the Football Queensland Junior Premier League Round Robins.

Football Wide Bay Development Teams 2009

Under 12 Girls

- Players will train weekly in their local CA Centre on a designated night with a designated coach.
- Players will train monthly as set down by Wide Bay.
- Players will play in a Club team.
- Players need to be available to play for their CA Representative Team.
- Players will train with their CA Representative Team.
- Players will compete in the Football Queensland Junior Premier League Round Robins.
- Players will be eligible for selection to the Queensland Team/ Development Camp relevant to their age.

Under 12 Boys – Harry Linning Team

- Players will train weekly in their local CA Centre on a designated night with a designated coach.
- Players will train monthly as set down by Wide Bay.
- Players will play in a Club team.
- Players need to be available to play for their CA Representative Team.
- Players will train with their CA Representative Team.
- Players will compete in the Football Queensland Harry Linning Carnival.

Under 13 Boys – Peter Cox Team

- Players will train weekly in their local CA Centre on a designated night with a designated coach.
- Players will train monthly as set down by Wide Bay.
- Players will play in a Club team.
- Players need to be available to play for their CA Representative Team.
- Players will train with their CA Representative Team.
- Players will compete in the Football Queensland Peter Cox State Carnival.

Extra Details

- Under 14 Boys, Under 15 Boys and Under 16 Girls *will complete* the Grassroots Coaching Course. As they will not be playing on Saturday **they will be expected to coach** a junior team for a Club.
- Under 14 Boys, Under 15 Boys and Under 16 Girls will be encouraged to complete a Referee Course and referee for their local CA.
- A bus will run from Bundaberg and Gympie to transport Centre of Excellence Full Time Teams to training on **Thursday nights**. This cost will be equalised in the costs of all COE players.
- Players who are selected into the Centre of Excellence full time team for Under 12 and Under 13 Boys but are unable to accept their position will be considered for the Harry Linning and Peter Cox teams.

Payment Details

- Costs will be kept to the minimum required to cover costs of training, accommodation and travel.
- Players will be required to make regular monthly payments as detailed in their invoice.

First payments will be due in February 2009.

Payment schedule for Centre of Excellence / Development Players :

15 th June	Balance of invoice.

If payment is not made by due date then player's guardians will be expected to make contact with the treasurer immediately to make arrangements for a payment plan to be set up. The plan negotiated will be confidential. It will be expected that the plan will be adhered to and if there is any difficulty the onus will be on the guardian to contact the Treasurer. Non-adherence to this could jeopardise the player's position in their team.

Football Wide Bay will endeavour to assist players and their families but the responsibility to communicate changes in circumstances rests with the guardians of the players.

• Payment Options

Football Wide Bay Inc. has several methods available for players to make payment .

1. **By Post** direct to - ***The Treasurer, Football Wide Bay Inc., 6 Wises Rd, GYMPIE 4570.***

If using this method please ensure payment is made via **either a cheque or money order** made payable to Football Wide Bay Inc.

It would be appreciated if full details of payment are recorded on the cheque or money order so the payment can be credited to the correct account.

2. **Bank Transfer via Internet Banking or Personal Deposit** - to the Zone's bank account.

Please ensure **details are included** - e.g. **Smith U13B Inv 456**. (Player Name, Squad Level and Boys or Girls plus Invoice Number if known).

With this method it is helpful if an email confirmation is sent to the Treasurer via email -

treasurer@footballwidebay.org . This payment may also be made at any Wide Bay Australia branch across the Zone. A DETAIL must be included during the transaction.

Note that you are a BUYER. ***The use of this facility incurs a fee which is a percentage of the amount being paid, currently around 3%.***

The Zone has setup the facility so you, as Buyer, pay this fee. If we did not use this option then we would

be 'out of pocket' and hence would need to increase fees to cover this extra cost.

To make a payment (Express Payment) you will need to provide our registered email address - treasurer@footballwidebay.org . From there it is simply, 'follow your nose'.

Please DO NOT give payments to either your Coach or Manager.

As a general rule, we do not issue Receipts, unless we are able to deliver them via email. So please advise your CURRENT email when making payments should you need a receipt.

To issue a receipt and post it is an expensive exercise and would necessitate an increase in fees. If you are willing to send a stamped addressed envelope with mail payments, then the Zone will issue a receipt.

Communication

- **The preferred method of communication is email.** It is therefore very important that you make every effort to have access to an email that you will check regularly – ie. more than once a week. To this end we will be asking everyone to confirm an email contact that will be your main email address for receiving communication from the zone. If you are unable to access email it is very important that you advise the administration officer so arrangements can be made.
- **SMS Messaging will also be an important means of communication in 2009.** We will need you to provide us with a mobile phone number that will be able to receive important messages. These will include items such as cancellation of training or that there is an important update on the website. The number provided will be included in special messaging groups so we will need to be contacted if you wish to change your contact details or you may miss out on some important information.
- **The Zone website is our other means of communication.** Please check regularly. www.footballwidebay.org

Communication is a 2 way process so it is imperative that you contact the Zone with any contact detail changes. ***We would also appreciate you directing any questions to the Administration Officer or Zone Personnel so we can address any issues.*** We will endeavour to keep you well informed and to keep the website updated but feedback would be greatly valued.
